## **GRANTS REPORT**

In the past year the Association applied for the following grants:

- **Calgary Foundation Community Grants Program** in mid 2017, the MPCA applied for a Community Grant to help fund the Pleasant Times Day Trips. We requested a grant in the amount of \$6,000. Unfortunately, the senior's request for funds was not supported.
- Calgary Foundation Stepping Stones Grant in May, a community member proposed hosting an all ages monthly bike maintenance event at the Community Hall. An application was submitted to the Stepping Stones Grant Program. The application was successful and \$600 was received for the Bike Maintenance Program.
- New Horizons for Seniors Program in June, the MPCA applied for funding from this Program. The funds were requested to maintain and expand the monthly lunches, day trips and exercise programs for the seniors in our community. A grant of \$20,000 was requested. We anticipate having a decision regarding the application in January.
- Capital Conservation Grant in September, the MPCA applied to the City for a Capital Conservation Grant to help cover the cost of remediating the roof on the Sportsplex. If we are successful, the grant will cover up to 75% of all eligible costs related to the project. Based on the cost estimate provided by Stantec for the roof repair, \$99,618.00 has been requested under this grant application. We should have a decision regarding this grant very soon.
