GRANTS REPORT

In the past year the Association applied for the following grants:

- **Calgary Foundation Community Grants Program** – in mid 2017, the MPCA applied for a Community Grant to help fund the Pleasant Times Day Trips. We requested a grant in the amount of \$6,000. Unfortunately, the senior's request for funds was not supported.
- **Calgary Foundation Stepping Stones Grant** – in May, a community member proposed hosting an all ages monthly bike maintenance event at the Community Hall. An application was submitted to the Stepping Stones Grant Program. The application was successful and \$600 was received for the Bike Maintenance Program.
- **New Horizons for Seniors Program** – in June, the MPCA applied for funding from this Program. The funds were requested to maintain and expand the monthly lunches, day trips and exercise programs for the seniors in our community. A grant of \$20,000 was requested. We anticipate having a decision regarding the application in January.
- **Capital Conservation Grant** – in September, the MPCA applied to the City for a Capital Conservation Grant to help cover the cost of remediating the roof on the Sportsplex. If we are successful, the grant will cover up to 75% of all eligible costs related to the project. Based on the cost estimate provided by Stantec for the roof repair, \$99,618.00 has been requested under this grant application. We should have a decision regarding this grant very soon.
